The Well-Read Dragons met at Davanni's Pizza. Sat., Oct. 6. The book discussed was Darkness Visible, A Novel of the 1892



Homestead Strike, by Trilby Busch.

Trilby is a member of our Society, and grew up in the valley of Homestead, Pa. She shared with us how she researched the book over a period of ten years and how she developed the characters in her book. She also shared how her German and Welsh ancestry linked to the people and events in the book.

The book was intriguing from the beginning as it wove the life of new immigrants into the town and culture of the new world. The main characters struggled with complex issues which conflicted with their ambitions and expectations. It was gripping how these issues were dealt with by the different characters. We had a fascinating hour of discussion which provided insight of the workers' struggle and sacrifice to organize unions in the early years of industrialization.

Our next meeting will be Sat., Dec. 1, 2012. We will be discussing Resistance, by Owen Sheers, a spell-binding book about the women in a Welsh village occupied by German soldiers. They struggle with one another to survive a harsh 1944 winter.

If you are interested in coming, you're welcome even if you haven't been able to read the book.
